- The program launches in fall 2022 with teachers receiving a one-time virtual or in-person visit from a Solar Decathlon competition alum.
- Educators will receive a lesson plan and gain exposure for students to the following career clusters: Architecture & Construction, Information Technology, Manufacturing, and STEM fields.
